If your daughter has had an exam recently, her physician may elect to complete the pink health (form 2) without a new exam. The health exam upon which the pink health form 2 is based must have been conducted after August 7, 2008 (within 24 months of the 2010 summer).

A Word Regarding ADHD Medications:
