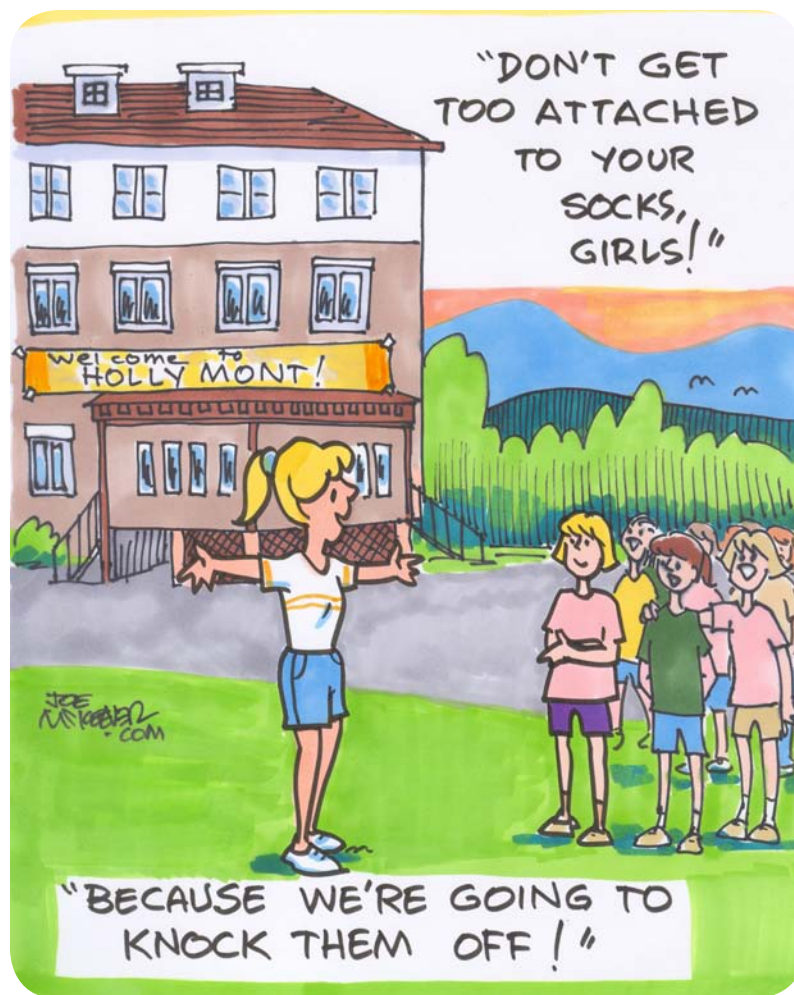
We've been busy around the Hollymont winter office reviewing the skills program and making changes for 2009. We want to have at least one new skill offered each session.
